
View claims by Law Firm

Identify competing firms



What happens when a claim is settled?




Filter claims by status:

- All all claims, irrespective of status
- Open all currently active claims
- Closed all claims closed before a court hearing
- Transferred any claim moved to a court that is not tracked


What happens when a claim goes to court?

- A claim will remain in the 'Open' list of claims until:
 - it is closed, transferred or,
 - a judgment is recorded against it
- If a judgement is recorded, the claim will:
 - a. Disappear from the claims view
 - b. Appear in the <u>cases</u> view navigate to claims via the main navigation
